It has been made possible to update the archive after editing a file containing Unicode file names.
(LZH, ZIP, 7z, RAR)

It corresponded to the correction of CAB file.

The file name encoding and the number of files are checked, and if there is an incorrect header, it will be corrected to a normal header.

In the environment set to [Regional Setting]-[Use Unicode UTF-8 for World Wide Language Support], file name characters in cabinet files containing ANSI multi-byte characters are garbled due to differences in encoding. To do. In "Modify CAB File", it is also possible to batch convert cabinet files on those UTF-8 environments into UTF-8 cabinet files.

Fixed a bug that could cause an invalid cabinet file to be created when deleting, adding, or renaming an existing cabinet archive that contains both ASCII and UTF-8 storage file names. did.
